
FM Insulation Supplies is working closely with Kingspan Tarec to bring this range of products to the Australian market.

We have a long association with Kingspan Tarec, having supplied a large quantity of Kooltherm phenolic pipe insulation to the OPAL Nuclear Reactor at Lucas Heights during it's construction. The material was used exclusively on all of the cooling water pipes and was chosen by the construction managers JHEDI and the reactor designers INVAP of Argentina ahead of other "plastic" insulation materials" because of it's superior fire resistance properties.



It is these same properties, plus its superior R value that is making Kooltherm a favourite with building designers & owners.

R-value tables for our range of Insulation Materials



Most of our contractor customers are aware of the clause in The Australian Insulation Standard (AS/NZS 4859.1: 2002) which details the formula for calculating the R-value for insulation materials for individual pipe sizes. This formula is used when converting the R-value gained from tests carried out on flat material (ASTM C653-97) to the R-value for pipe insulation.

We are in the process of compiling tables for our glasswool, rockwool & chemically cross linked polyethylene pipe insulation. We expect to have these tables on our web site early in the New Year. In the meantime, users can calculate their own thicknesses based on our currently published R-values all of which "are based on "flat insulation"

These R-values can currently be found in our technical data sheets and on our cartons of rockwool & glasswool spi as well as the bags of chemically cross linked pipe insulation.

Application Notes

Use of mastics on insulation for copper, steel & iron pipes. A recent event in Queensland has highlighted a problem with the use of mastics used as joint sealers or bedding compounds on copper pipes. It appears that a number of mastics that have been used in such applications over a number of years are not recommended by the mastic manufacturer for this application. As always we urge our customers to check the applicability of all products before use.

Website update
