Over the past twelve months, we have been discussing the use of our products on Westfield Projects with Research & Development,



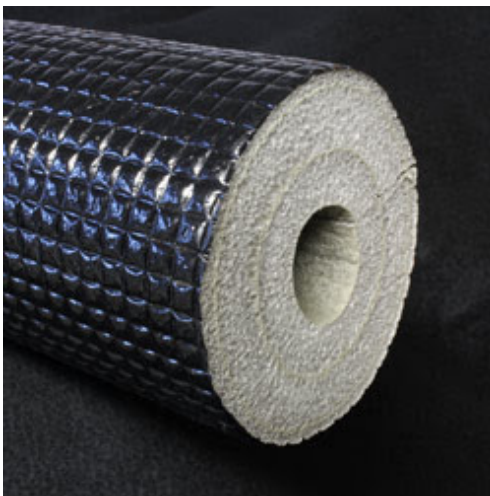
Design and Risk Management staff at Scentre Group.

Meanwhile, we continue to extend our range of Polyethylene pipe and sheet/rolls. We now carry f/f PE sheeting with adhesive backing in a number of thicknesses in addition to our range of standard foil faced PE sheet/roll.
